


Tridesetogodišnji rat (1618.-1648.) jedan je od najvažnijih sukoba u europskoj povijesti. Iako je započeo kao sukob katoličke i protestantske strane unutar Svetog Rimskog Carstva Njemačke Narodnosti, te iako je vjerska problematika bila od velike važnosti tijekom cijelog rata, u rat se zbog svojih partikularnih, često sasvim svjetovnih interesa, uključio niz europskih država. U ovom paneuropskom sukobu istaknuto ulogu imali su hrvatski vojnici, koji su zbog svojeg karakterističnog načina ratovanja istovremeno izazivali prijezir i poštovanje.

Na ovoj izložbi prikazan je izbor iz arhivskog gradiva o sudjelovanju Hrvata u Tridesetogodišnjem ratu koji se čuva u Hrvatskom državnom arhivu, Metropolitanoj knjižnici Zagrebačke nadbiskupije, Austrijskom državnom arhivu, Arhivu Republike Slovenije, Vojnopolovisnom muzeju u Beču te Vojnom muzeju u Stockholmumu. Prezentirano je gradivo o nizu još uvijek nedostatno istraženih tema iz povijesti hrvatskih postrojbi u Tridesetogodišnjem ratu, od sudjelovanja u bitkama, problematike nasilja, njihova izgleda i opreme, do biografija istaknutih pojedinaca.

The Thirty Years' War (1618-1648) is one of the most important conflicts in European history. Even though it began as a conflict between the Catholic and the Protestant side within the Holy Roman Empire of the German Nation and although the religious problems were of great importance during the entire war, a whole number of European states joined the war due to their own particular and often completely secular interests. The Croatian soldiers played a distinguished role in this pan-European conflict. Due to their specific waging of war they provoked both contempt and respect.


This exhibition shows the selection of archival records about the participation of Croats in the Thirty Years' War kept in the Croatian State Archives, the Metropolitan Library of the Archdiocese of Zagreb, the Austrian State Archives, Archives of the Republic of Slovenia, the Vienna Museum of Military History and the Military Museum in Stockholm. The presented records pertain to as of yet numerous insufficiently researched subjects from the history of Croatian troops in the Thirty Years' War, from their participation in battles, issues concerning violence, their appearance and equipment, to biographies of renowned individuals.
